

The WSET Level 1 Award in Wines.

This qualification was initially created for the front-of-house staff within the on-trade sector. It has grown into a course with global appeal, providing basic product knowledge to first time employees in the wine industry and the interested consumer alike.

Aim of the course:

The aim of the course is to give a basic introduction to wine followed by some basic food and wine pairing. Successful students will receive a certificate and WSET Level 1 Award in wine lapel pin.

- Storage and service of wine.
- An introduction to wine tasting.
